Application deadlines are December 31, March 31, June 30, and September 30. Once the quarter closes, the Aureon Grant Committee will review all applications and letters of support and determine the projects that will be awarded funds. Both the applicant and the local broadband provider/telco will be notified of the application status after the committee meeting. The review process is generally completed by the end of the month following the quarter's close. Only communities served by Aureon participating telecommunications companies are eligible to submit applications.
